Background

A meeting of the Professional Advisory Committee (PAC) convened on January 22, 2026, to review the credentials of three hundred and ninety-eight (398) artists who submitted qualifications from a National Call to Artists for public art opportunities at the new Royal Caribbean Group Terminal G at PortMiami. This project comprises the expansion and development of a state-of-the-art, LEED Silver-certified terminal facility for Royal Caribbean Group, engineered to accommodate next-generation vessels, including the Oasis Class, with passenger capacities exceeding 7,000 guests. Opportunities for public art include, but are not limited to, free-standing exterior sculptural artworks for placement in the new plaza connecting the terminal building with the garage, applications and or treatments to two large-scale planters bordering the pathways to the terminal, free-standing monumental sculptural installation for the main lobby entrance, that may include artist-designed seating elements and durable wall-based artwork, video and or time-based media artworks for digital display, and durable wall-based applications throughout the terminals.

At the conclusion of the panel deliberations, the PAC unanimously recommended inviting the following shortlist of twelve (12) artists to develop proposal concepts for one or more of the two- and three-dimensional commission opportunities:
