Trust Resolution No. APPT 26-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT I TO THE PROFESSIONAL ARTIST SERVICES AGREEMENT IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE FORM ATTACHED WITH LIAM GILLICK TO CHANGE THE ARTIST’S CONTRACTUAL NAME TO LIAM GILLICK ART, LLC (LEAD ARTIST LIAM GILLICK) FOR PHASE I DESIGN AND PHASE II FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION OF THE INTEGRATED CONTROL AND COMMAND CENTER FAÇADE PROJECT (MIAMI-DADE PEOPLE AND INTERNAL OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT PUBLIC ART FUNDS).

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Art in Public Places Trust approve Amendment I to the Professional Artist Services with Liam Gillick to change the Artist’s contractual name to Liam Gillick Art LLC. All other terms of the Professional Artist Services Agreement in substantially the form attached with Liam Gillick, now Liam Gillick Art, LLC (lead artist Liam Gillick), shall remain in place for Phase I Design and Phase II Fabrication and Installation of the Integrated Control and Command Center façade project.

Background

On October 7, 2025 through approval of Resolution APPT 25-50, the Trust authorized a professional artist services agreement with internationally renown New York-based artist Liam Gillick for implementation of his proposal concept “Code Clear” for the new Miami-Dade Integrated Control and Command Center. The artist’s proposal explored the various states of readiness as abstract color expanding across all four (4) building facades clad with metal panels. Since then, the artist has been working closely with the project team and APP staff to develop the final design including selection of paint colors, finish treatment, and placement of each color scheme to each façade grid. As the artist nears completion of the Phase I-Design Services, he’s requested to have the contractual responsibility of the commission changed to his newly formed corporate entity known as Liam Gillick Art, LLC.

APP staff recommends the approval of Trust Resolution No. APPT 26-10 authorizing Amendment I to the Professional Artist Services agreement with Liam Gillick to change the Artist’s contractual name to Liam Gillick Art, LLC (lead artist Liam Gillick.) All other terms and conditions of the current contract for the Miami-Dade County Integrated Command and Control Center for the façade project shall remain in effect.
