RESOLUTION APPROVING ADDENDUM I TO THE PROFESSIONAL ARTIST SERVICES AGREEMENT IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE FORM ATTACHED WITH LOPEZ DE VICTORIA STUDIO, LLC (LEAD ARTIST MONICA LOPEZ DE VICTORIA) IN THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$127,500.00 FOR PHASE II – FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION OF THE TECHNOLOGY BASED ARTWORK FOR THE SOUTH DADE TRANSITWAY CORRIDOR PROJECT (FROM MIAMI-DADE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS PUBLIC ART FUNDS)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Art in Public Places Trust approve Addendum I to the Professional Artist Services Agreement in substantially the form attached with Lopez De Victoria Studio, LLC (lead artist Monica Lopez de Victoria) in the not-to-exceed amount of \$127,500.00 for Phase II – Fabrication and Installation of the technology-based artwork for the South Dade Transitway Corridor project.

Background

On May 10, 2022 through approval of Trust Resolution No. APPT 22-21, the Trust authorized a Professional Artist Services Agreement with Lopez De Victoria Studio, LLC (lead artist Monica Lopez de Victoria) in the initial amount of \$22,500.00 for design development of her proposed technology-based artwork for a prominent area in the park-and-ride garage of the South Dade Transitway Corridor project. In close collaboration with APP staff and the client's executive team, the artist is nearing design completion of a video installation which will include a series of LED screen panel cabinets attached to an exterior wall section of the garage station. Design development for this type of work has been primarily focused on defining the hardware, software, and infrastructure requirements for developing a self-contained and reliable system to display the artist's produced video over an anticipated lifespan of 5-7 years with little to no monitoring. The fabrication phase of this commission involves the artist's production of the video-specific content and the assembly of the custom display LED system for installation close to the completion date and opening of the new garage facility. Approval of the artist's substantially complete design by the project's A&E team is expected before end of June 2023. The artist has confirmed her readiness to initiate the 8-10 months production/fabrication phase upon approval of the design package submittal.

APP staff recommends the approval of Trust Resolution No. APPT 23-40 authorizing Addendum I to the Professional Artist Services Agreement with Lopez De Victoria Studio, LLC in the not-to-exceed amount of \$127,500.00 for fabrication and installation of the approved artist's design. Execution of this addendum is contingent on the artist's successful completion and submittal of all deliverables required under the Phase I - Design scope of work.
