For a combined total expenditure amount not-to-exceed \$6,800.00 for the Doral Branch Library project.

Background

A meeting of the Professional Advisory Committee (PAC) convened on June 15, 2023 with the purpose of reviewing artist qualifications for the Doral Branch Library, a new library facility on NW 53 Terrace between NW 87 Avenue and NW 84 Avenue. The 3-story building features a semi-covered terrace on the third floor facing Downtown Doral Park. The ground floor includes a welcoming lobby with a double-height atrium space, grand staircase, and multipurpose room. The second floor houses the children and young adult areas. The third floor houses the adult area and library staff spaces. This building takes advantage of an open floor plan, modern design and materials, and quality views. Approximately \$100,000.00 is available for public art.

Opportunities for public art included but are not limited to applications to the north exterior wall stair tower, a suspended artist designed sculpture and lighting element or application to interior atrium and stairwell wall, and / or durable application beneath the exterior roof terrace canopy. After careful deliberation and input from the client teams, the PAC unanimously recommended inviting the following eight (8) artists to create full proposals for a new commission and/or acquisition of existing artwork:
