Idea Summary	Mr. Pita suggested that WASD collect donations to help eligible WASD customers with emergency water and sewer bill assistance. Developed in partnership with the Community Action and Human Service Department (CAHSD), the WASD Cares Program is already helping those in need as envisioned.	Mr. Clingerman recommended adjustments to various electrical control components and valve calibrations to increase the performance and efficiency of the well pump station at the NDWTP.
