

Memorandum of Understanding

between

Pinellas County Tax Collector

and

Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections

This Memorandum of Understanding defines and establishes a working relationship between Pinellas County Government's Tax Collector and Supervisor of Elections. Both parties agree to provide the citizens of Pinellas County with telephone access in the event one of them should experience an isolated loss of phone service or in the case of an emergency in their respective facilities.

Pinellas County Tax Collector will:

- Make approximately 10 - 15 phone/computer workstations available for the Supervisor of Elections at the Tax Collector's US 19 Clearwater office, or other office to be determined and agreed upon by both parties.
- Contact the Supervisor of Elections as soon as possible to request the use of its phone bank at its Starkey Road office.

Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections will:

- Make approximately 10 - 15 phone/computer workstations available for the Tax Collector at the Supervisor of Elections Starkey Road office.
- Contact the Tax Collector as soon as possible to request the use of its phone bank at its US 19 Clearwater office.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall take effect on the date signed by both parties and shall remain in effect until modified or cancelled by one or both parties. Modifications may be made at any time if both parties agree on the modifications, and such modifications are reduced to writing and made an addendum to this statement.
